Eventually the song became widely known in Europe, where it was used by Agatha Christie. The song was included in the first film version of And Then There Were None (1945), which largely took Green's lyrics and replaced the already sensitive word "nigger" with "Indian" as African Americans began to score legal and social victories at the turn of the 20th century" (Jennings, 2012).
