Editing Tutorial - ArcGIS

Certain editing operations may require additional licensing, such as ArcGIS for Desktop Standard, Advanced, or an ArcGIS extension. For example, ArcGIS for Desktop Basic allows you to edit simple features in a geodatabase but cannot be used to edit more advanced geodatabase capabilities such as topologies, dimensions, geometric networks, and ArcSDE geodatabases.

Using ArcCatalog or the Catalog window in ArcGIS for Desktop, you can quickly edit the properties of a service. To edit the properties of a service, follow these steps: In the Catalog tree, expand the GIS Servers node. Double-click Add ArcGIS Server and establish an Administer GIS server connection type to the server.

If you are building an app in which your users need to edit features offline, use the editing workflow described in Edit features. Before going offline, provision a local geodatabase using ArcGIS for Desktop or create one from a sync-enabled feature service using the API, as described in Create an offline map .

In 10.1 and later versions, services are restarted automatically. If your ArcGIS Server site has a large number of services, it may take a significant amount of time for all the services to restart. A recommended practice is to adequately plan and test your ArcGIS Server deployment so that you do not have to edit the server's directories.

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Understanding the ArcGIS 10 desktop editing environment At ArcGIS 9.3.1 and earlier, edits were performed via commands, tasks, and tools against an edit target. To create a feature, for example, you specified the editor's target layer, set the edit task to Create New Feature, then typically used the sketch tool to create a geometry that ultimately created a new feature.
