Emphasize key words. Don't "talk down" to the person with aphasia. Give them time to speak. Resist the urge to finish sentences or offer words. Communicate with drawings, gestures, writing and facial expressions in addition to speech. Confirm that you are communicating successfully with "yes" and "no" questions.

Structure the learning environment to minimize distractions for your students with aphasia. Use simple language and uncomplicated sentences when communicating with students with aphasia. Repeat words as necessary when speaking with students with aphasia.

SCA can be helpful for people with all types of aphasia. Its goal is to improve conversation for people who have trouble speaking or understanding language. Treatment focuses on the communication partner, not the person with aphasia. SCA asks the person with aphasia and the communication partner to work together to improve communication.

A general 'rule of thumb' is that when speaking to persons with aphasia, therapists should simplify and dignify spoken messages for the patient. Simplification involves making necessary changes in wording or syntax, speaking to the patient directly, and minimizing the need for inference.
